## Cincinnati LEND LPQI Process

- Discuss LPQI at LEND Core Faculty Meeting
- Orient LEND Core Faculty to LPQI instruments
- Assign LEND trainees to LEND Core Faculty based on discipline
- LEND Core Faculty sends email to trainee's clinical supervisors with overview of LPQI and instruments and due date for return
- Clinical supervisors complete LPQI on trainee and return completed forms to LEND Core Faculty

## Cincinnati LEND LPQI Process, Continued

- LEND Core Faculty collect instruments from supervisors and bring to LEND Faculty Meeting
- LEND Core Faculty meet as group to review and discuss each trainee
- LEND Core Faculty come to consensus on ratings for each trainee (2 – 2.5 hours)
- Once ratings are completed, LEND Data Coordinator enters data for each trainee into LPQI dashboard



#### Cincinnati LEND LPQI Process, Benefits

- Supervisors who see trainees in clinical settings are able to rate trainees
- Fruitful discussion between LEND faculty
- LEND program able to emphasize critical components of FCC and Interdisciplinary Practice to providers outside of LEND program



# Cincinnati LEND LPQI Process, Challenges

- Getting ratings back from clinical supervisors required extra time and extra prompting
- Team was slow in calibrating ratings for first few trainees until they had flow with process
- Clinical supervisors often rated trainees higher than expected, not recognizing the developmental nature of the instruments and not wanting to rate trainees anywhere below highest rating



## Cincinnati LEND LPQI Process, Next Steps

- Allow more time for clinical supervisors to complete instruments
- Remind clinical supervisors of intent and developmental nature of the instruments
